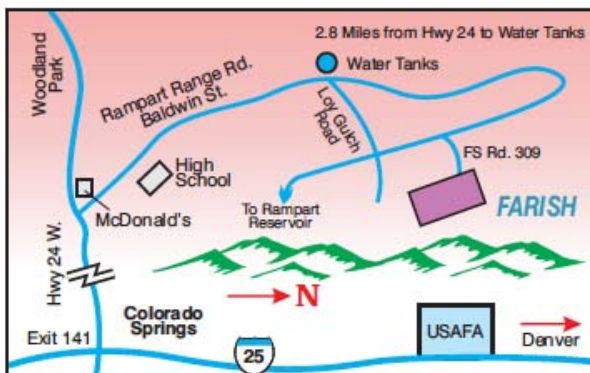
Farish Brochure

Exclusive mountain resort comes to mind when describing Farish Recreation Area. A 655 acre alpine paradise of mountains and meadows at an altitude of 9200 feet, this treasure is located on the Rampart Range west of the United States Air Force Academy.

EASY DIRECTIONS

Farish is a 7 1/2 mile hike from the Academy via the Stanley Canyon Trail or about 45 minutes by car.


Take Interstate 25 to Exit 141, then head west on Highway 24 to Woodland Park. Turn right at the third stop light (Baldwin Street at McDonald's turns into Rampart Range Road) and follow Rampart Range Road to its end (big water tank on left). Look for the Farish sign and take the fork to the right (Loy Creek Road). Go up the hill to the three-way stop, then make a left on the dirt road and follow the signs to Farish Recreation Area.

Lodging, Cabins & Campsites

HISTORICAL TO CONTEMPORARY LODGING

Farish offers a variety of lodging facilities — from comfortable lodge rooms to roughing it in a tent in the great outdoors.

The cottage sleeps eight, has a gas log fireplace, sofa, TV, table and chairs, and a fully equipped small kitchen. The master bedroom has a queen-size bed. The second bedroom has two queen and two single beds.

The historic lodge has four bedrooms that each sleep up to four people. Each room has a queen size bed and a set of bunk beds. Room 1 has a fireplace and a private bath; rooms 2, 3 and 4 share two community bathrooms. Room 3, also has a fireplace.

The building right next door to the lodge holds the kitchen and a dining room that seats up to 25 people, with stoves, refrigerators and enough basic utensils to accommodate each room.

The six modern duplex suites, adjacent to the Multi-Purpose Center, have vistas that will leave you breathless. Two of the suites are handicap accessible. Each unit sleeps five, has its own kitchen, living room, stove top (no oven), bath and two bedrooms or a loft.

Seven rustic log camper cabins for overnight summer reservations. Two cabins have electricity and five do not. Each cabin sleeps four people and has a cooking grill and picnic table. Campers must bring their own sleeping bags and cooking fuel.

Camp sites are located at Lakes Leo and Sapphire, Most sites can accommodate 6 people and

- Seven outdoor pavilions are available for groups to use. The main pavilion on Lake Leo can host groups of up to 125 and is across the road from an outdoor volleyball court and horseshoe pit.

Fish three well stocked lakes or enjoy our pedal boats on the water. Hike or bike the miles of trails on Farish or venture onto the thousands of acres of National Forest that surround Farish. Book one of our tent sites and camp out.

RESERVATIONS

Reservations will be taken up to 90 days in advance Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

PETS

Pets are allowed in all Campsites and Camper Cabins. Duplex units C & D (below the Multipurpose Building) are pet friendly, however, there is an additional fee per night. Pets are not allowed to be tied up outside or kept in vehicles overnight. Overnight and day use patrons must have their pets on a leash at all times while outside.
